SHOW REGULATIONS

The show site will be accessible at 7:00 AM,

A recording fee of 50 cents will be required for each dog entered at any license or Member Club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 14, Section 2).

Entry fees are \$35.00 for regular classes. Additional entry of same dog is \$20.00. Veterans Class is \$20.00. These fees include a \$3.00 event fee and a 50 cent American Kennel Club recording fee. Sweepstakes entry fee is \$20.00., Veteran Sweepstakes entry fee is \$20.00. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch is \$20.00, Generations is \$20.00. Junior Showmanship is free. Dogs entered in the American Bred Classes must have been whelped in the United States by reason of a mating which took place in the United States (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 6, Section 8).

Foreign dogs (dogs not whelped in the USA or Canada) are eligible for Puppy and Open Classes effective, January 1, 1985.

Make all checks and money orders payable in U.S. funds to DOG SHOW IN A BOX. Checks or money orders must be sent with entries.

Telephone, Telegraph, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not accepted.

Return checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.

BEST OF BREED

Judges Award of Merit

Two Awards of Merit will be awarded after Best of Breed judging is completed to Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs in the Best of Breed competition that exemplify the breed's characteristics. These awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed. The dogs selected for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not eligible for an Award of Merit. At the judge's discretion, up to two awards of merit will be awarded in the Best of Breed competition, which shall include move-ups, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and first place in Veteran Dog and Bitch Classes.

Chapter 11, Section 8, of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, provides that neutered dogs may be entered as the Stud Dog.

Non Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

These classes will be judged after the Best of Breed judging.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dog and a minimum of two (2); maximum of four (4) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Note

BROOD BITCH CLASS –Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Bred by Exhibitor Class Eligibility

All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

From the West on I-64: Exit from I-64 at exit 143 onto Rt. 208 and turn north (right) toward Ferncliff. After one-half mile, turn left onto Rt. 250 East. After 3.6 miles, turn left onto Rt. 604 (Roundabout Rd). After .8 miles, turn right onto gravel road Foster Trail. Please drive slowly until you reach the gate--code is on the keypad.

Junior Showmanship Competition

Novice Junior Class for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year.
